- Offering year-round villa and cottage accommodation in Nuoksio National Park. A total of 52 overnight guest spaces in 8 log villas. In addition, it organizes activity services, hiking and kayaking trips in the surrounding nature, as well as various courses related to nature experiences. It also organizes workshops and tours that contribute to the biodiversity in the area.

- Conference, recreation and seminar services for groups and companies are also available. Hawkhill's forest restaurant offers local based and sustainable menus using berries, mushrooms and wild herbs from the woods

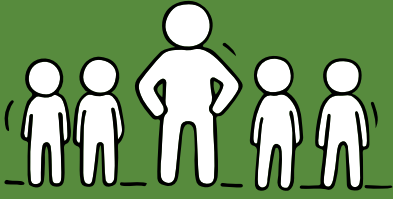

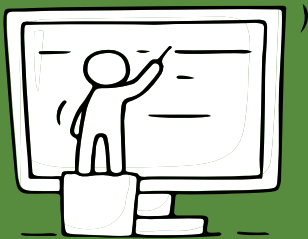

Hawkhill is surrounded by Nuuksio National park forest owning land area of 27 ha including forest, rock, boggy land, field and meadow. Land has been here long before us that's why we see important to take care of its biodiversity with all possible ways. We have resorted our 6 ha bog on as climate action.

'Restoring of our meadow is in process. The most sensitive part of our land is rock called Hawkhill covered with moss and lichen we have made marked trail around it to avoid erosion. We are also fighting against alien species on our land and inviting our partners to do so. Playing music outdoors is forbidden. We avoid making light pollution.

Energy

We only use solar, thermalpower and electricity for heating. Only fossil free electricity is used

Waste

At Hawkhill we and our guests sort all the waste. 80% of waste is sorted and only 20 % is mixed waste. 100% of bottles cans are recycled. 100% of waste in our restaurant kitchen is sorted

Transport and other emissions

We have now 3 electricity powered cars for our transportation . We encourage our guests to use public and joint transportation.

Promote Healthy and Enjoyable Activities

All activities we offer are somehow connected with nature surrounded by us.

We want to add awareness of nature, biodiversity and local natural and cultural history. Doing together and by terms of locals is important for us.

We have also several activities which have regenerative mind setting. Building birdhouses, bug hotels, dead wood fences getting rid of garden lupin.

Local mindfulness and yoga teacher has created forest based meditative activities: forest meditation, hammock relaxation, morning yoga by the lake
